On the Main Approaches to Implementing Activities on Protecting Intellectual Property Rights on the Internet Information and Telecommunications Network in the Member States of the Eurasian Economic Union

In accordance with Article 89, Paragraph 2, Subparagraph 5 of the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union dated May 29, 2014,

considering the distribution of the information infringing intellectual property rights on the Internet information and telecommunications network (hereinafter the Internet),

and for the purposes of ensuring the protection of intellectual property rights, including on the Internet,

the Board of the Eurasian Economic Commission **recommends** that the Member States of the Eurasian Economic Union (hereinafter, the Member States, the Union), from the date of publishing this Recommendation on the Union's official website:

1. As part of the Member States' activities to protect intellectual property rights on the Internet, use the results of the analysis by the Eurasian Economic Commission (hereinafter the Commission) of international experience and the Member States' legislation and law enforcement practice on combating intellectual property infringements on the Internet (information placed on the

<http://www.eurasiancommission.org/ru/act/finpol/dobd/intelsobs/Documents/АнализИнтернет.pdf>) which identified the following most efficient tools and mechanisms in the above sphere:

procedures on the restriction of access to the information infringing intellectual property rights on the Internet in a judicial procedure;

procedures of pretrial dispute settlement for the purposes of termination and prevention of intellectual property infringements on the Internet;

procedures on the restriction of access to the information resource that illegally hosts objects of intellectual property and is confusingly similar (identical) to a restricted information resource;

accounting and systematization of restricted information resources;

procedures on the resumption of access to information resources after deleting the information infringing intellectual property rights on the Internet;

procedures on the deletion from search engines of links to the information infringing intellectual property rights on the Internet;

conclusion of agreements on cooperation in the sphere of protecting intellectual property rights between rightholders and Internet platforms offering goods for sale via the Internet;

organization of information exchange between rightholders, Internet platforms offering goods for sale via the Internet and the state authorities of the Member States authorized in the sphere of protecting intellectual property rights.

2. Create with the participation of the Commission a working group on the development of the agreed approaches for combating intellectual property infringements on the Internet within the Union under the leadership of the Member of the Board — Minister in charge of Economy and Financial Policy of the Commission.
